

# One-Minute Club

## Note-Naming Challenge

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### Levels

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#### 1 | Bass F to Treble G [10 notes]

- 3 Landmarks: Bass F + Middle C (x2) + Treble C
- All notes between Bass F and Treble G

#### 2 | Bass C to Treble C [16 notes]

- 6 Landmarks: Bass C/F + Middle C (x2) + Treble G/C
- All notes between Bass C and Treble C

#### 3 | All notes on Grand Staff [24 notes]

- 8 Landmarks: Low F + Bass C/F + Middle C (x2) + Treble G/C + High G
- All notes between Low F and High G

#### 4 | Ledger Lines (outer and inner) [16 notes]

- 8 Landmarks: Low C/F + Middle C(x2) + Ledger F above and G below Middle C + High G/C
- All notes between Low C/F, Middle C/Ledger F, Ledger G/Middle C, High G/C

#### 5 | All notes including ledgers [36 notes]

- 12 Landmarks: Low C/F+ Bass C/F + Middle F/C(x2)/G + Treble G/C + High G/C
- All notes between Low C and High C including the inner middle ledgers

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### Steps for Practicing / Quizzing Notes

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1. Teacher names note, student plays.
2. Student names note without playing.
3. Student names note and plays (timing).

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### Rules

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- Students will begin at level 1 every year and work their way up.
- Student must play *and* name the notes in one minute or less to move to the next level.
- Bass clef notes should be played with LH and treble clef notes with RH.
- Students must complete 2 successful timings under one minute (preferably at 2 different lessons) before moving on to the next level. The fastest time will be counted for that level.
- Students continue to participate until they win level 5. Once students win level 5, they “graduate” from this annual challenge.

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### Prizes

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- One winner at each of levels 1-4 will receive a \$5 gift card (surprise location).
- One overall winner (level 5) gets a \$15 gift card to a location of their choice and their picture on the One-Minute Club board.
